Starting points are again at Stud Park Shopping Centre, Rowville, Melbourne and Hastings. A free sausage sizzle is available before journeying onto Mornington.



AOMC Delegates Report Meeting Date 21.11.2016. Venue. Chevrolet Car Clubrooms. Moorabbin.

Guest Speaker. Tonight's guest speaker was Paul Tsiaras from Statewide 4x4. This company carries out GVM (gross vehicle mass) upgrades of vehicles, particularly 4x4s. Much of his talk was in regard to towing ratings, and in particular GVM, towing capacity and gross combined mass. Many of their modifications are for mining vehicles, which never use public roads and are crushed at the end of their use. Several stories were told of their experiences with vehicles and caravans which were in excess of the stated ratings resulting in insurance refusal and resultant court cases.


